

STELLAT'EN FIRST NATION OFFICIAL NOTICE of NOMINATION MEETING

Notice is hereby given that a **Nomination Meeting** of the electors of the **STELLAT'EN FIRST NATION** for the purpose of nominating candidates for one (1) Chief and four(4) Councillor positions for the Band Council's next 3 year term of office will be held from June 8th 2022 at 8:00am to 8:00pm.

A Nomination package will be mailed to every Stellat'en Member for whom the band has a address.

Any member of the Stellat'en First Nation 18 years or older and on the voters list, may nominate or second a nomination for the position of Chief or Councillor, by filling out the Candidate Supporter Form. This must be completed before the end of Nomination Meeting.

Members must meet the eligibility requirements to be a candidate as set out in the Stellat'en First Nation Custom Election Code 2015 Amended (2022), being:

REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDACY


- Candidates must be at least 18 years of age by July 28, 2022;
- A registered Stellat'en First Nation member;
- Include a Nomination Form with 5 Members who support your nomination;
- Include proof of completion of the required Governance Training;
- Include a Criminal Record Check from this year;
- \$100 Nomination Fee;
- Willing to live in Stellat'en Traditional Territory if elected.

To ensure that your nomination is valid all the necessary documentation must be completed and received by Electoral Office by 8:00pm June 8th 2022

The Electoral Officer will be at the Stellaquo New Hall-Stellat'en Community Hall 559 Meljai Ti, Stellat'en Reserve From 8am until 8 pm to receive Nominations.
