The Stellat'en First Nation will hold a General Voting day for the election of One (1) Chief and Four (4) Councillors for a three-year term, in accordance with the Stellat'en First Nation Custom Election Code (2022), amended 2017.

DATE: Thursday July 28, 2022
VOTING HOURS: 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
LOCATION OF POLL Stellat'en Community Hall
559 Meljai Trail, Stellat'en Reserve

Three options for voting:

In person at the Stellat'en Community Hall

On line Voting (information to access included), due to admistration requirements will commences June 19th until July 28 at 8pm.

Mail in Ballots which will be mail out on request from members. Completed ballots must be received by the Electoral Officer before 8pm July 28 2022.

The votes will be counted at the **Stellaquo New Hall - Stellat'en Community Hall** immediately following the close of the Poll on July 28, 2022. To keep the number of people to a minimum, only 1 scrutineer per candidate will be permitted to attend the count. The results will be announced, and the successful candidates declared elected after this count has been completed subject to the provisions of the Stellat'en First Nation Custom Election Code (2015), amended 2022.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE VOTING

This is the software used by Loreen Suhr to conduct online voting. It makes voting more convenient, less costly and friendlier on the environment.

How Simply Voting Works

1. Go to on line voting web site **stellaten.simplyvoting.com** to get to the welcome page. Then, submit your Elector ID (4 digit number provided) and Password Date of Birth.
2. If your login was successful, you will be shown a menu listing all current ballots in which you are eligible to vote. If you have not yet voted, you may click on the ballot name,(ie Chief Ballot or Councillor Ballot) and an electronic ballot will appear.
3. Make your choice and mark the ballot
4. Submit the ballot
5. Once you submit a ballot, the results are encrypted and stored in a database. Your Elector ID is then flagged as "voted" and will not be eligible to vote on this ballot again.
